

# The Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association North of Scotland Branch Confined Solo Snare Drumming Contest

**Held under the RSPBA Contest Rules, subject to the following Branch Rules.**

1. Confined to registered members of the North of Scotland Branch, RSPBA.
2. All competitors to commence performance with 2 three pace rolls
3. **Competition Sections**

<b>Section 1 – 12 years &amp; under</b>	Sticks & Pad. 4 parts March tempo.
<b>Section 2 – 14 years &amp; under</b>	4 – 6 parts March tempo
<b>Section 3 – 17 years &amp; under</b>	6 – 8 parts March tempo
<b>Section 4 – 17 yrs &amp; under</b>	March, Strathspey & Reel. Min 4 parts each
<b>Section 5 – 17 yrs &amp; under</b>	Hornpipe & Jig. Min 4 parts each

Section 4 &5 are Open to competitors from Sections 2 & 3.  
Must enter Section 4 before being able to enter Section 5.  
Section 4 & 5 Combined Overall Winner (MSR preference if tied)

<b>Section 6 – 18 years &amp; over</b>	March, Strathspey & Reel. Min 4 parts each
<b>Section 7 – 18 years &amp; over</b>	Hornpipe & Jig. Min 4 parts each

Section 6 & 7 Combined Overall Winner (MSR preference if tied)
4. Competitors in Section 1 must not yet be playing on a drum.
5. Hornpipe will commence with 3 pace intro rolls and competitors will break from Hornpipe into Jig (Sections 5 and 7)
6. Age will be that attained on the day of the contest
7. Entries to with the Branch Secretary by closing date **Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2009**
8. Late entries will not be accepted.
9. Bands are asked to supply a representative who will be responsible for ensuring compliance with Education Authority Rule of Let (Copy attached)
10. Please enclose a stamped, addressed A5 envelope for the draw.
