General Contest Rules

The contest will be conducted under the rules of the RSPBA, subject to Branch Rules.

1. Date of the Contest is **4th November 2017**
2. Closing Date for Entries is Saturday **14th October 2017** at 5:00 pm
Late Entries **will not** be accepted.
3. Completed Entry forms must be returned to the Secretary (details below) by the Closing Date.
4. Entry Fees are as per the Entry Form. Payment in full **must** accompany the Entry Form.

Cheques only, must be made payable to: **RSPBA North of Scotland Branch**

Fee is non-returnable if competitor withdraws.

5. **TROPHIES:** Branch rules stipulate that all trophies from the previous competition **must be returned to the Trophy Convenor** (details below) **on, or before the Closing Date**, (or exceptionally to the Branch Secretary by prior arrangement). Please make contact by telephone or by e-mail to confirm arrangements. It is the member Band's responsibility to ensure trophies are returned clean and in good condition as stipulated above. The member Band shall bear the cost of any repair, and, in the case of any loss, the replacement value as determined by the Management Committee.

Failure to comply means that any entry will be excluded from the contest draw. Also, in accordance with the rules of The Company, the Directors may levy a fine for late return of trophies of £50 per trophy capped at £250 per member Band. All amounts shall be notified in writing and recovery made from the member Band, not an individual band member. Until such time as all monies due are paid to the Treasurer the member Band will be suspended and unable to participate in any RSPBA activities. Thank you for your full cooperation.

6. The Playing requirements are as per the Entry Form. Any changes to playing requirements are subject to Director's approval in advance of the competition.
7. Each Band will have a Band Representative, who will be responsible for their Band's compliance with any Accommodation Rules of Let.
8. Each Competitor will be given a time to play. It is the responsibility of the Competitor, or their Band representative, to ensure they arrive at the designated performance area ready to play at the allocated time; Competitors not ready to play at the allocated time may be disqualified.
9. Details of the Draw will be published on Branch media.
10. **All** withdrawals or non-attendances from the competition must be notified to the Branch Secretary at least one hour prior to the competition starting time for that Grade. In case of transport breakdown, please contact the Secretary (details below).

Contest Specific rules

1. This Contest is confined to members of Bands from the North of Scotland Branch.
2. **ONLY ONE ENTRANT PER ENTRY FORM**
3. Age will be that attained on the day of the contest

SNARE DRUMMING

4. **Section 1** - Competitors must not yet be playing a drum.
5. All competitors to commence performance with 2 x 3-pace rolls
6. **Sections 4 & 5** are open to Competitors from Section 2 & 3
7. Competitors must compete in Section 4 before being allowed to compete in Section 5
8. **Section 5 & 7** - Hornpipe & Jig will commence with 2 x 3-pace rolls and competitors will break directly from Hornpipe into Jig

TENOR DRUMMING

9. **Section 8** entrants may also compete in Section 9, but not in Section 10
10. Competitors must compete in Section 8 before being allowed to compete in Section 9
11. **Section 9** entrants may also compete in Section 10
12. Competitors must compete in Section 9 before being allowed to compete in Section 10

Section 8 entrants can play up to Section 9, and Section 9 to Section 10
